***Gateway Conference Option.** The Gateway Conference Option allows students who participate in the annual Gateway Conference (Southlake, Texas) the opportunity to integrate the conference with their academic study in these particular classes. Students will enroll in all regularly scheduled classes and residencies, but may chose this option and notify the instructor, who will offer alternate assignments which will allow students to consider and integrate the conference content into the class.

Live Web Classes. In addition to ongoing asynchronous discussions, all online classes will require several real-time web conferences throughout the class, typically 3-4 times per class. These will allow the students and instructors to stay connected with one another throughout their time in the program, and to engage in rich dialogue around important class concepts. Students should plan to be available to spend approximately 90 minutes in each web conference, which will be scheduled by the instructor at the beginning of the class. Mondays at 7PM CST is the anticipated time for web conference sessions for each class.
